From the East: Follow MD Route 140 from Westminster to Emmitsburg. Continue thru Emmitsburg, MD on Route 140 heading West into PA. Route 140 becomes Route 16 in PA. Follow Route 16 through Waynesboro, and then Greencastle toward Mercersburg. Follow Route 16 several miles to Mercersburg. Turn LEFT after Cemetery onto Route 75 (Fort Loudon Road). Follow for 2-3 miles. Camp Tohiglo will be on your LEFT.

From the North: Follow I-81 South to Greencastle, PA Exit 5. Turn RIGHT onto Route 16 toward Mercersburg. Follow Route 16 for several miles to Mercersburg. Turn LEFT after Cemetery onto Route 75 (Fort Loudon Road). Follow for 2-3 miles. Camp Tohiglo will be on your LEFT.

From the South: Follow I-81 North to Maryland Exit 7b onto MD Route 58 (Cearfoss Pike) West. Follow MD Route 58 for several miles until it comes to a circle intersection (round-about). Yield RIGHT around the circle and go ¾ of the way around and start heading South. Go SOUTH for only 50 feet and take the immediate RIGHT onto MD Route 494. Follow MD 494 into PA. Route 494 becomes PA Route 75. Several miles north of the MD line you will pass Kasiesville Bible Church. Camp Tohiglo will then be 1+ miles on the RIGHT.
